

## FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear People of God,

Praise the Lord. Good morning to you. As we draw close to the end of the liturgical year, we are reminded of the Day of the Lord through this Sunday's readings.

In today's first reading, Malachi announces the coming of the day of the Lord. He paints two pictures: the fate of the evil doer, and the triumph of the righteous who endures till the end. This short reading simply serves as an encouragement to us to continue our good work in patient righteousness and endurance. It teaches that to persist in good works till the end, one must endure all forms of trials and difficulties as some Saints did. Today's first reading ends with a promise: "But for you who fear my name, there will be arise the sun of justice with its healing rays" (Malachi 3: 20a)

In the second reading, Paul encouraged us to work hard to earn both our earthly and heavenly living. Good work is a product of endurance; it yields good and enduring fruits as well. Therefore, one must persevere in it until it begins to yield good fruits.

In the gospel, Jesus encourages us to persevere in righteousness and endure in hard work. Furthermore,

in warning that in spite of the elegance of the temple that it will be destroyed, Jesus warns us not to hold on tenaciously to anything of this world to the detriment of forgetting God because the only things that will endure are faith, hope, and trust in God which are manifested through charity – the love of God, as well as the love of neighbor. So, rather than fix our gaze on the glory of this world, we must keep all our eyes on Jesus the author and finisher of our faith (Heb12, 2).

Here Jesus is also assuring his followers that God is present to all believers, even in times of trouble. As disciples of Jesus, we need to try to follow his example, trusting in God's mercy and protection, even when we are facing difficulties. We should be always prepared since we do not know the day or the hour that Christ will come again nor the moment of our death. For that we need to lead lives that are in accordance with His commandments.

## HUNTER'S MASS

## MARTYR

Is one who voluntarily suffers death rather than deny their religion by words or deeds; such action is afforded special, institutionalized recognition in most major religions of the world. The term may also refer to anyone who sacrifices their life or something of great value for the sake of principle.

## SAINT BONIFACE

(born 675, Wessex, Eng.—died June 5, 754, Dokkum, Frisia; feast day June 5), English missionary and reformer. Originally named Wynfrith, was an English monk and Priest. He organized significant foundations of the church in Germany and was made archbishop of Mainz by Pope Gregory III. He was martyred (killed by a band of Frisians while reading the Bible to recent converts) in Frisia in 754, along with 52 others, and his remains were returned to Fulda, where they rest in a sarcophagus which has become a site of pilgrimage.



Boniface's life and death as well as his work became widely known, there being a wealth of material available — a number of vitae, especially the near-contemporary Vita Bonifatii auctore

Willibaldi, legal documents, possibly some sermons, and above all his correspondence. He is venerated as a saint in the Christian church and became the patron saint of Germania, known as the "Apostle to the Germans".

Norman F. Cantor notes the three roles Boniface played that made him "one of the truly outstanding creators of the first Europe, as the apostle of Germania, the reformer of the Frankish church, and the chief fomenter of the alliance between the Pope and a wealthy family, the Carolingian family. Through his efforts to reorganize and regulate the church of the Franks, he helped shape the Latin Church in Europe, and many of the dioceses he proposed remain today. After his martyrdom, he was quickly hailed as a saint in Fulda and other areas in Germania and in England. He is still venerated strongly today by German Catholics. Boniface is celebrated as a missionary; he is regarded as a unifier of Europe, and he is regarded by German Roman Catholics as a national figure.
