

FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear people of God,

Christ Our Lord is risen today! Alleluia! Alleluia!! Today, we celebrate the Resurrection of Christ! This event is the greatest event in our Catholic faith. It is through the resurrection that Christ defeated sin and death and opened for us the gates to eternal life. A journey that began sorrowfully on Ash Wednesday has ended joyfully toady.
